CURRENT FIRE WEATHER FOR LAS VEGAS, PHOENIX, FLAGSTAFF, AND TUCSON

LAS VEGAS WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...A WEAK PACIFIC STORM IS EXPECTED TO MOVE THROUGH THE REGION THURSDAY BRINGING A SLIGHT CHANCE OF SHOWERS TO THE SIERRA ALONG WITH LOCALLY BREEZY CONDITIONS ELSEWHERE. TEMPERATURES WILL COOL TO NEAR NORMAL BEHIND THIS SYSTEM FRIDAY BUT A WARMING TREND IS EXPECTED SUNDAY AND MONDAY AS HIGH PRESSURE BUILDS OVER THE AREA.

FLAGSTAFF WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...CLEAR SKIES AND LIGHT WINDS WILL CONTINUE THROUGH TONIGHT. A DRY [LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM](#) WILL BRING BREEZY SOUTHWEST WINDS ON THURSDAY...ALONG WITH A 5 TO 10 DEGREE DECREASE IN HIGH TEMPERATURES LASTING THROUGH THE WEEKEND. A GRADUAL WARMING TREND CAN BE EXPECTED NEXT WEEK AS HIGH PRESSURE REBUILDS ACROSS THE SOUTHWEST STATES.

PHOENIX WEATHER DISCUSSION

EXPECT A CONTINUATION OF WELL ABOVE NORMAL DAYTIME HIGHS THROUGH THURSDAY AS HIGH PRESSURE ALOFT PERSISTS OVER THE WESTERN UNITED STATES. A WEAK WEATHER DISTURBANCE WILL BRING SLIGHTLY COOLER WEATHER FRIDAY AND SATURDAY...THOUGH DAYTIME HIGHS WILL REMAIN A FEW DEGREES ABOVE NORMAL. HIGH PRESSURE ALOFT WILL REDEVELOP OVER THE SOUTHWEST UNITED STATES SUNDAY THROUGH TUESDAY...BRINGING A WARMING TREND WITH A RETURN TO WELL ABOVE NORMAL TEMPERATURES. NO [PRECIPITATION](#) IS FORECAST DURING THE NEXT SEVEN DAYS.

TUCSON WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...DRY CONDITIONS WILL PREVAIL INTO EARLY NEXT WEEK. EXPECT UNSEASONABLY WARM DAYTIME TEMPERATURES THROUGH THURSDAY FOLLOWED BY SOME COOLING BY THIS WEEKEND.
